Subject: Medical Reimbursement claim in favour of Mr. Sandeep Bhagat, Driver, Medical Block Beerwah for the medical expenses incurred on treatment of his father at Max Super Specialty Hospital, New Delhi, in relaxation of rules.

Ex-post facto sanction is hereby accorded to the reimbursement of the medical expenses incurred by Mr. Sandeep Bhagat, Driver, Medical Block Beerwah on treatment of his father outside J&K at Max Super Speciality Hospital, New Delhi, in relaxation of rule 6-A the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Services (Medical Attendance-cum-Allowance) Rules, 1990, subject to the following conditions:

- i) Reimbursement of charges shall be restricted to items / procedures admissible under rules for the period of hospitalization and cost thereof shall be restricted to the extent of rates as applicable to such items / procedures at AIIMS, New Delhi.
- ii) All relevant medical bills / vouchers shall be got verified from relevant Medical Authority of the hospital wherefrom treatment has been taken.
- iii) Essentiality certificate on Form 2 issued by the hospital authorities is obtained and kept on records.
- iv) Follow up(s), if any, is regulated under rules.
- v) Certificate from Competent Medical Authority (Director Health Services / Principal GMC / Other) is obtained to certify that the drugs and services charged are reasonable and to establish the genuineness of the treatment availed in the said hospital.
- vi) Dependence of the patient on the official is established under rule before reimbursement of the claim.

This issues with the concurrence of Finance Department conveyed vide U. O No. A / 27 (2008) - 723 / J / 18 dated 07.08.2020 and General Administration Department's approval conveyed vide O.M No. GDC - 186 / CM / 2020 dated 25.11.2020.
