Subject: Settlement of period of undergoing higher studies (Senior Residency course) in favour of Dr. Farooq Ahmad Teli, Consultant Medicine.

WHEREAS, Dr. Farooq Ahmad Teli while undergoing Sr. Residency at SKIMS Soura, Srinagar was appointed as Consultant Medicine vide Government Order No. 123-HME of 2012 dated 22.02.2012 and the said doctor joined in the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir on 12.03.2012. However, concerned doctor preferred to continue the higher study course in pursuance of the directions dated 04.04.2012 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in SWP No.644/2012 ;

AND WHEREAS, the operative part of the order dated 04.04.2012 passed by the Hon'ble High Court in SWP No. 644/2012 titled Dr. Farooq Ahmad Teli & others V/s State & Ors. is reproduced as under:-

"Notice returnable within four weeks, notice in the CMP also returnable within same period. Steps for service within one week. In the meantime, subject to objections of the other side, appointment of the petitioners against which the posts of B.Grade Specialists shall not be disturbed and they be permitted to continue with the present assignment till next date of hearing"

AND WHEREAS, Dr. Farooq Ahmad Teli, Consultant Medicine, after completion of Senior Residency has rejoined in the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir on 08.09.2012 and his services were being utilized at SDH Yaripora;

AND WHEREAS, Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir has forwarded the case regarding settlement of higher studies to the Administrative Department for issuance of appropriate necessary instructions;

AND WHEREAS, the instant case has been examined in consultation with Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department (Chairman Departmental Designated Committee), and the department while taking considerate view in the matter, in the interest of patient care, decided to treat the period of Senior Residency at SKIMS Soura, Srinagar w.e.f. 12.03.2012 to 07.09.2012, in favour of Dr. Farooq Ahmad Teli, Consultant Medicine as extension in joining time which is without any financial

implications and this shall be subject to outcome of SWP No.644/2012 titled Dr. Farooq Ahmad Teli, & Ors Vs State of J&K and subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any Govt./Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir from the concerned doctor. The concerned doctor shall also be warned not to leave his place of posting un-authorizedly for any occasion in future, failing which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.

Now, therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

- i. treat the period of Senior Residency at SKIMS Soura, Srinagar w.e.f. 12.03.2012 to 07.09.2012, in favour of Dr. Farooq Ahmad Teli, Consultant Medicine, as extension in joining time which is without any financial implications and this shall be subject to outcome of SWP No.644/2012 titled Dr. Farooq Ahmad Teli, & Ors Vs State of J&K and subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any Govt./Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir from the concerned doctor.

Further, the concerned doctor is **warned** not to leave his place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action will be initiated against him without any further notice.
