Subject:- **Settlement of period of absence (authorized/un-authorized) of Dr. Deepkia Wazir, Medical Officer (ISM).**

WHEREAS, Dr. Deepika Wazir was appointed as Medical Officer, Ayurvedic in Health & Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 121-HME of 2001 dated 13.02.2001 and joined in the Directorate of ISM on 14.02.2001. The said doctor proceeded on study leave for (02 years, 5 months and 8 days) without pay for undergoing PG course;

AND WHEREAS, vide Govt. Order No. 77-HME of 2010 dated 03.02.2010, she was supposed to join back her duties on 17.11.2011 which she failed to join as reported by the Deputy Director, ISM Jammu vide letter No. DDISM/J/1035 dated 20.02.2016;

AND WHEREAS, after issuance of notice, the said doctor submitted her joining report in the Directorate of ISM on 23.04.2016 and the same was referred to the Administrative Department. The aforesaid doctor worked at Govt. Ayurvedic Hospital Jammu w.e.f 23.04.2016 to 28.02.2017 and the salary of the said doctor of this period has not been drawn;

AND WHEREAS, the Health & Medical Education Department vide letter No. HD/ISM/26/2016 dated 20.12.2016, requested Director, ISM to communicate a vacant post of Medical Officer for adjustment of Dr. Deepkia Wazir. Subsequently, vide Govt. Order No. 48-HME of 2017 dated 30.01.2017, the said doctor was posted at Government ISM Dispensary Sunjwan and has joined on 01.03.2017 as reported by ADMO Jammu;

AND WHEREAS, Directorate of Indian Systems of Medicine, J&K has recommended the case of Dr. Deepika Wazir, Medical Officer (ISM) for settlement of authorized/un-authorized period w.e.f 17. 11. 2011 to 22.04.2016 with the stipulation that the period be treated as extra-ordinary leave without pay and allowances in terms of rule 163 of Jammu & Kashmir Civil Service Regulation Rules, 1956 from the date of her joining i.e 23.04.2016;

AND WHEREAS, the instance case has been examined in the department in consultation with Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department (Chairman, Departmental Designated Committee), and the department while taking a considerate view in the matter, in the interest of patient care, decided the period of un-authorized absence w.e.f 17.11.2011 to 22.04.2016 in respect of Deepika Wazir, Medical Officer (Ayurvedic) as Dies- Non subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any private sector for which an affidavit authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of ISM, J&K from the concerned doctor and treat the period of work at Govt. Ayurvedic Hospital Jammu w.e.f 23.04.2016 to 28.02.2017 as duty subject to condition that she has regular attendance in Govt. Ayurvedic Hospital Jammu, which shall be certified by the controlling officer. The concerned doctor shall be warned not to leave her place of posting un-authorizedly for any occasion in future, falling which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice and the Director, ISM has to fix the responsibility who were dealing hands in Directorate and didn't initiate any action against her including those who allowed her to work in Government Ayurvedic Hospital Jammu without

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acceptance of her joining by the Administrative Department and report be furnished within a month.

Now, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

- I. treat the period of un-authorized absence w.e.f 17.11.2011 to 22.04.2016 in respect of Dr. Deepika Wazir, Medical Officer (Ayurvedic) as Dies-Non subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any private sector for which an affidavit authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of ISM, J&K from the concerned doctor.
- II. treat the period worked at Government Ayurvedic Hospital Jammu w.e.f 23.04.2016 to 28.02.2017 as duty subject to condition that she has regular attendance in Govt. Ayurvedic Hospital Jammu, which shall be certified by the concerned controlling officer.
- III. Director, ISM has to fix the responsibility who were dealing hands in Directorate and didn't initiate any action against her including those who allowed her to work in Government Ayurvedic Hospital Jammu without acceptance of her joining by the Administrative Department and report be furnished within a month.

The concerned doctor shall be warned not to leave her place of posting un-authorizedly for any occasion in future, falling which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice.
