WHEREAS, Dr. Zahoor Ahmad Bhat was appointed as Medical Officer in the Health Services Department vide Government Order No. 639-HME of 2016 dated 09-12-2016 and reported in the office of Director Health Services, Kashmir on 20-12-2016;

AND WHEREAS, vide Government Order No.33-HME of 2017 dated 20-01-2017, the aforesaid doctor was posted at NTPHC Nadigam, Shopian. However, as the said doctor was undergoing Registrarship at the time of his appointment and continued the same on the directions of Hon'ble Court issued under SWP No:89/2017 MP No.01/2017 titled Dr. Aiyaz Ali Mir & Ors Vs State of J&K and Ors. The said doctor after completion of his course reported to Director Health Services, Kashmir on 01-01-2016. Now Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir has submitted the case with regard to settlement of period of Dr. Zahoor Ahmad Bhat.

AND WHEREAS, the instant case has been examined in consultation with Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department (Chairman, Departmental Designated Committee), and the department while taking a considerate view in the matter, in the interest of patient care, decided to treat the period of undergoing higher studies (Registrarship at GMC Srinagar) w.e.f 20-12-2016 to 31-12-2019 in favour of Dr. Zahoor Ahmad Bhat, Medical Officer as extension in joining time which shall be without any financial implication and shall be subject to outcome of SWP NO.89/2017 titled Dr. Aiyaz Ali Mir and Ors. Vs State and Ors. Besides, rejoining of the said doctor shall be accepted notionally from 01-01-2020 and monetarily with immediate effect. Besides, the concerned doctor shall be warned not to leave his place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly in future for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.

Now, therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

- i. treat the period of undergoing higher studies (Registrarship at GMC Srinagar) w.e.f 20-12-2016 to 31-12-2019 in favour of Dr. Zahoor Ahmad Bhat, Medical Officer as extension in joining time



- i. which shall be without any financial implication and shall be subject to outcome of SWP NO.89/2017 titled Dr. Aiyaz Ali Mir and Ors. Vs State and Ors.
- ii. accept the rejoining of the said doctor notionally from 01-01-2020 and monetarily with immediate effect.

Besides, the concerned doctor is **warned** not to leave his place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.
