

- ii. That the doctor(s) shall have no superior claim over their seniors for consideration for promotion after acquiring higher qualification;
- iii. The course undertaken is purely in public interest and shall prove beneficial to the Department;





- iv. That the stipend, scholarship etc., if any, received by the doctor(s) during study leave is adjusted in their salary and;
- v. The doctor(s) shall execute a bond in Form-6, in terms of the rule 64(3) of the Jammu and Kashmir Civil Service (Leave) Rules, 1979.
