. The provisional No Objection Certificate is granted subject to the following terms & conditions:-

- i. That the institute shall fulfill all the deficiencies as laid down in Government order No.86-HME of 2008 dated 25.01.2018 within a period of six months from the date of issuance of order and the institute shall give an affidavit of completing all the requirements prescribed in the order.
- ii. If the institute fails to fulfill the deficiencies within a period of six months, failing which the paramedical institute shall be closed down without further notice.
- iii. No capitation fee will be charged by the management.

- iv. The permission shall be subject to any policy on the subject which the Government may sanction in future for regulation of these institutes.
- v. Eligibility of candidates for the admission to various courses through J&K Board of Professional Entrance Examination shall be made on merit basis as per the provisions laid down by the Government from time to time.
- vi. The J&K Paramedical Nursing Council shall conduct the inspection of the institute periodically to monitor and assess the adequacy of infrastructure in relation to the number of trainees.
- vii. An amount of Rs. 5000/- per trainee per session shall be charged from the institution on account of providing hospital facility and the amount so received shall be utilized for hospital development fund of the hospital.
- viii. J&K State Paramedical/Nursing Council shall conduct examination of the trainees on the same pattern as in the case of trainees in AMT School.
- ix. Candidates shall get registered with the concerned Council within one month of admission.
