Subject: Settlement of period of undergoing higher studies (Fellowship Programme) in favour of Dr. Azad Ahmad Shah, Lecturer, Government Medical College Srinagar.

WHEREAS, Dr. Azad Ahmad Shah was appointed as Lecturer in the Government Medical College, Srinagar vide Government Order No. 350-HME of 2018 dated 06-06-2018 and he submitted joining report in Government Medical College, Srinagar on 19-06-2018;

AND WHEREAS, Dr. Azad Ahmad Shah, Lecturer, Government Medical College, Srinagar had been selected for Fellowship Programme at University of Hong Kong, w.e.f 01-08-2018 to 01-01-2019 and had applied for grant of study leave for the purpose. The said doctor left without obtaining prior permission/NOC of the Administrative Department;

AND WHEREAS, the H&ME Department vide communication No. ME(Gaz)-146/2018 dated 29-01-2019 has asked Principal GMC Srinagar to allow the Dr. Azad Ahmad Shah, Lecturer, Orthopaedics Bone & Joint Hospital Srinagar to resume his duties, besides, the period spent on pursuing fellowship Programme in the Department of Orthopaedics and Traumatology, University of Hong Kong w.e.f 01-08-2018 to 01-01-2019 shall be decided separately;

AND WHEREAS, after the completion of course, the aforesaid doctor re-joined in Government Medical College, Srinagar on 02-01-2019;

AND WHEREAS, the Principal Government Medical College, Srinagar forwarded his case regarding settlement of period of higher studies to the Administrative Department for issuance of appropriate necessary instructions.

AND WHEREAS, the issue with regard to settlement of the intervening study/training period was examined in consultation with Director Finance, Health and Medical Education Department (Chairman, Departmental Designated Committee) and the Department while taking considerate view in the matter, decided to treat the period of undergoing higher studies (Fellowship Programme) in the Department of Orthopaedics and Traumatology, University of Hong Kong w.e.f 01-08-2018 to 01-01-2019 in respect of Dr. Azad Ahmad Shah, Lecturer, GMC Srinagar as Dies Non, subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any Govt./private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by the Ist Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Principal, Government Medical College, Srinagar from the concerned doctor. Government Medical College, Srinagar shall explain as to why disciplinary proceeding was not initiated against Dr. Azad Ahmad Shah, Lecturer, GMC Srinagar for undergoing higher studies abroad without obtaining prior permission/NOC of the competent authority. The concerned doctor shall be warned not to leave his place of posting un-authorizedly for any occasion in future, failing which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.

Now therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

- i. Treat the period of undergoing higher studies (Fellowship Programme) in the Department of Orthopaedics and Traumatology, University of Hong Kong w.e.f 01-08-2018 to 01-01-2019 in respect of Dr. Azad Ahmad Shah, Lecturer, Government Medical College, Srinagar as "**Dies Non**", subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any Govt./private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Principal Government Medical College, Srinagar from the concerned doctor.

Besides, Principal Government Medical College, Srinagar shall explain as to why disciplinary proceeding was not initiated against Dr. Azad Ahmad Shah, Lecturer, GMC Srinagar for undergoing higher studies abroad without obtaining prior permission/NOC of the competent authority.

Further, the concerned doctor is **warned** not to leave his place of posting un-authorizedly for any occasion in future, failing which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.
