- Reimbursement of charges shall be restricted to items / procedures admissible under rules for the period of hospitalization w.e.f 29.11.2017 to 05.12.2017.
- All relevant medical bills / vouchers are verified and countersigned by the Competent Medical Authority of the hospital wherefrom the treatment has been taken.
- Essentiality certificate on Form 2 issued by the hospital authorities is obtained and kept on records.
