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**Subject:** Initiation of Departmental action against Dr. Muneer Ahmad Masoodi, the then Medical Superintendent SMHS Hospital, Srinagar, Dr. Shabir Ahmad, the then Deputy Medical Superintendent, Dr. Nazir Ahmad Khan, the then RMO causality and Dr. Ajaz Ahmad Baba, the then RMO, SMHS Hospital Srinagar.

**WHEREAS,** vide O.M. No. GAD(Vig)20-RDA/2018 dated 06.04.2018, General Administration Department forwarded the letter No. SVO-Med-G-60/2011-2937-38 dated 20.02.2018 alongwith its enclosures received from Vigilance Organization, J&K, Jammu (now ACB) for initiation of Regular Departmental Action against Dr. Muneer Ahmad Masoodi, the then medical Superintendent SMHS Hospital, Srinagar, Dr. Shabir Ahmad, the then Deputy Medical Superintendent, Dr. Nazir Ahmad Khan, the then RMO causality and Dr. Ajaz Ahmad Baba, the then RMO in terms of J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956;

**AND WHEREAS,** vide O.M. No. HME/HRM/87/2018 dated 23.10.2019 charge sheets were served to these officers through the Principal, Government Medical College, and Srinagar;

**AND WHEREAS,** vide letter No. AH/EST-I/2020/122 dated 08.01.2020, Administrator, Associated Hospitals, Srinagar has furnished the replies/statement of defense submitted by these doctors;

**AND WHEREAS,** the replies submitted by these alleged officers were examined in the department and it was decided to enquire into the matter by appointing an Inquiry Officer;

**AND WHEREAS,** in terms of sub-rule 4 of Rule 33 of the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control & Appeal) Rules, 1956, vide Government Order No. 164-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 14.02.2020, Mr. Mohammad Rafiq, Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department was appointed as Inquiry Officer to enquire into the charges leveled against these officers and it was also ordered that he shall furnish his report alongwith his specific recommendations within a period of three weeks from the date of issuance of the order. Mr. Fayaz Ahmad Bhat, Administrative Officer, Government Medical College, Srinagar was appointed as Presenting Officer;

**AND WHEREAS,** the Inquiry Officer has furnished the enquiry report on 05.02.2021 with the following recommendations:-

"1. The findings are suggestive that Dr. Shabir Ahmad Dar and Dr. Nazir Ahmed Khan have not contributed to the loss of the state exchequer in any way and so has been the case with Dr. Ajaz Ahmad Baba, who was on properly sanctioned (earned) leave.

2. As far as Dr. Muneer Ahmad Masoodi is concerned who has evidently made the procurement in a pressure situation, has actually retired on superannuation w.e.f 31.07.2011, thus making application of penal clause of Rule 30 of J&K CCA rules, 1956, after a gap of almost a decade very difficult, rather impossible.
3. The absence of technical knowledge also, seems to be the crucial link to have catalyzed the deviations pointed out, therefore, it is advisable to instruct the line departments to apportion the verification assignment meticulously.
4. All the serving officers need to be formally alerted to be cautious for future while handling such assignments."

**AND WHEREAS**, the report submitted by the Inquiry Officer has been examined in the department and the same was placed before the competent authority for acceptance.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, the enquiry report is hereby accepted and it is ordered that:-

- i) case against Dr. Muneer Ahmad Masoodi, the then Medical Superintendent, SMHS Hospital, Srinagar (now retired) is closed in terms of Article 168-A of J&K Civil Services Regulation, Volume-I;
- ii) case against Dr. Ajaz Ahmad Baba, the then RMO is closed as he was on sanctioned (earned) leave at that period of time;
- iii) case against Dr. Shabir Ahmad, the then Deputy Medical Superintendent and Dr. Nazir Ahmad Khan, the then RMO causality is closed as per the recommendations of the Inquiry officer. However, they are warned to be cautious in future while handling such assignments;
