Subject: Settlement of period of undergoing higher studies (DNB in Gastroenterology) in favour of Dr. Mohammad Muzaffar Mir, Medical Officer.

Ref: No. Est/3/1-133/2178 dated 08-10-2020 from Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir.

WHEREAS, Dr. Mohammad Muzaffar Mir was appointed as Medical Officer in the Health Services Department vide Government Order No.639-HME of 2016 dated 09.12.2016 and he submitted his joining report in the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir on 22-12-2016;

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid doctor was selected for undergoing DNB in Gastroenterology at GMC Srinagar w.e.f 27-03-2017 to 26-05-2020. The Directorate of Health Services Kashmir vide communication No. Est/3/1-133/6206-07 dated 24-03-2017 had submitted case to the H&ME Department for further necessary instructions and orders.

AND WHEREAS, the H&ME Department vide communication No. HD/Gaz/Gen/06/2017 dated 23-10-2017 had directed to Director, Health Services, Kashmir to take necessary action in the matter as per para (iii) of the letter No. HD/Legal/Gaz/MR-38/2017 dated 25-09-2017, wherein it was mentioned that the "Study leave under SRO-274 of 2013 shall be granted in favour of the Medical Officers willing to pursue PG courses who have completed their three years of service/probationary period and in case of Medical Officers who have not completed their three years of service they shall be permitted to undergo PG courses and period spent by them on pursuing PG course shall be treated as leave whatever kind due and the remaining period shall be treated as Dies-Non."

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid doctor had only 03 months of service at his credit, as such, period of probation was incomplete and he left for higher studies without prior permission of competent authority;

AND WHEREAS, the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir has forwarded his case regarding re-joining/settlement of period of higher studies to the Administrative Department for issuance of appropriate instructions;





AND WHEREAS, the issue with regard to settlement of the intervening period was examined in consultation with Director Finance, Health and Medical Education Department (Chairman, Departmental Designated Committee) and the Department while taking considerate view in the matter, decided to accept the rejoining in respect Dr. Mohammad Muzaffar Mir, Medical Officer notionally w.e.f 27-05-2020 and monetarily with immediate effect and to treat the period of undergoing DNB in Gastroenterology at Government Medical College, Srinagar w.e.f 27-03-2017 to 26-05-2020 as "**Dies-Non**", subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any Govt./private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by the Ist Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir from the concerned doctor.

Now, therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

- i. accept the rejoining in respect Dr. Mohammad Muzaffar Mir, Medical Officer notionally w.e.f 27-05-2020 and monetarily with immediate effect.
- ii. Treat the period of undergoing DNB in Gastroenterology at GMC Srinagar w.e.f 27-03-2017 to 26-05-2020 in respect of Dr. Mohammad Muzaffar Mir, Medical Officer as "**Dies-Non**" subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any Govt./private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by the Ist Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services Kashmir from the concerned doctor.

Further, the concerned doctor is warned not to leave his place of posting un-authorizedly for any occasion in future, failing which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice.

Besides, Director, Health Services, Kashmir is asked to fix the responsibility as to who were dealing hands in Directorate and didn't initiate any action against him with a report to be furnished within a month.
