Subject:- Notification of Minimum Qualifications for Recruitment and Method of Recruitment for various categories of faculty posts /Gazetted level posts for 500 bedded New Paediatric Hospital (Government Medical College, Srinagar) Bemina, Srinagar.

Dated: 20 - 07 - 2021

WHEREAS, vide Government Order No.70-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 20.01.2020, faculty posts of different categories were created for 500 bedded new Paediatric Hospital (Government Medical College, Srinagar) at Bemina, Srinagar;

AND WHEREAS, vide Government Order No.49-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 19.01.2021, read with Government Order No.448-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 17.06.2021, the minimum qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment has been notified for different categories of faculty posts/gazetted level posts for various sub-specialties of this 500 bedded new Paediatric Hospital, Srinagar;

AND WHEREAS, in respect of one sub-specialty, which was created as the sub-specialty of 'Paediatric Haematology/Oncology', the minimum qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment for the faculty posts/gazetted level posts could not be notified for the reason that the Health and Medical Education Department had, with concurrence of Finance Department, submitted a

proposal to the General Administration Department for placement before the Competent Authority for approval to the change in nomenclature of this sub-specialty as the sub-specialty of 'Paediatric Haematology';

AND WHEREAS, on the basis of the approval of the Competent Authority, conveyed by the General Administration Department vide O.M No.GAD-COORD/15/2021-09-GAD dated 21.06.2021, vide Government Order No.458-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 24.06.2021, the name of the sub-specialty of 'Paediatric Haematology/Oncology' has been changed as the sub-specialty of 'Paediatric Haematology';

AND WHEREAS, the following posts have been created for the sub-specialty of Paediatric Haematology, vide Government Order No.70-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 20.01.2020:-

AND WHEREAS, among others, a post of Paediatric Haematologist (Lecturer) has earlier been created in GMC, Srinagar (G. B. Pant Children Hospital), vide Government

Order No.322-HME of 2006 dated 19.05.2006 and vide Government Order No.528-HME of 2012 dated 28.08.2012, the minimum qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment has, among others, been notified for this post;

AND WHEREAS, for the above faculty posts/ gazetted level posts created vide Government Order No.70-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 20.01.2020, the minimum qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment are required to be notified. Besides the qualifications prescribed for direct recruitment to the post of Lecturer (Paediatric Haematologist) earlier, vide Government Order No.528-HME of 2012 dated 20.09.2012, also require to be modified/ updated so as to maintain uniformity with the qualifications being prescribed now for the newly created posts.

Now, therefore, the minimum qualifications for recruitment and method of recruitment for the faculty posts/ other gazetted level posts for the sub-specialty of 'Paediatric Haematology' are hereby notified as per the details indicated in **Annexure-'A'** to this Government Order. The notification of these qualifications in respect of the Paediatric Haematologist (Lecturer) shall be in supersession of the minimum qualifications for recruitment prescribed for this post vide Government Order 528-HME of 2012 dated 28.08.2012. Further, the notification of these qualifications shall be

without prejudice to the qualifications possessed by the Paediatric Haematologist (Lecturer) appointed earlier as per the qualifications prescribed vide Government Order No.528-HME of 2012 dated 28.08.2012, which are being modified now, and the said Paediatric Haematologist (Lecturer) shall be eligible for promotion to the higher faculty posts on the basis of qualifications on which he was earlier appointed on the recommendations of the J&K Public Service Commission.
