
**Government Order No: 317 -JK(HME) of 2021**  
**Dated: 26-04-2021**

WHEREAS, Dr. Sashank Sharma was appointed as Medical Officer in the Health Services Department vide Government Order No. 333-HME of 2018 dated 29-05-2018. However, at the time of his appointment, the said doctor was undergoing DNB Superspeciality in Gastroenterology at Batra Hospital and Medical Research Centre, New Delhi and applied for extension in joining time upto completion of his DNB course;

AND WHEREAS, the Health and Medical Education Department vide Government Order No. 630-HME of 2018 dated 20.11.2018, among others, accorded sanction to the extension of joining time in respect of Dr. Sashank Sharma, Medical Officer (figuring at S. No. 29 in the Annexure) upto 03/2020;

AND WHEREAS, Dr. Sashank Sharma, Medical Officer couldn't join on 01-04-2020 i.e immediately after expiry of his authorized extension of joining period due to the reasons that COVID-19 restrictions were in force and he was not able to leave the station. Besides, his final examinations were held from 24th to 26th September, 2020, for which documentary evidences have been provided by the concerned doctor;

AND WHEREAS, after the completion of said course and appearing in the final examinations, the concerned doctor joined in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu on 05-10-2020 and Directorate of Health Services, Jammu vide communications No.ES-3/6365/3120 dated 09-01-2021 & No.ES-3/6365/4360 dated 30-03-2021 forwarded his case to the Administrative Department for issuance of appropriate necessary instructions;








AND WHEREAS, the issue with regard to settlement of the intervening period of study course was examined in consultation with the Director Finance, Health and Medical Education Department (Chairman, Departmental Designated Committee) and keeping in view the COVID-19 restrictions at that time, the Department while taking considerate view in the matter & in the interest of patient care, decided to accept the joining of Dr. Sashank Sharma, Medical Officer, notionally from the date he has submitted joining report in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu i.e. 05-10-2020 and monetarily with immediate effect and treat the remaining period of undergoing of higher studies (DNB Superspeciality in Gastroenterology) at Batra Hospital and Medical Research Centre, New Delhi w.e.f 01-04-2020 to 04-10-2020 in favour of Dr. Sashank Sharma, Medical Officer as extension of joining time which is without any financial implication. However, this shall be subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any Govt./private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Director, Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor. Besides, the concerned doctor shall be warned not to leave his place of posting unauthorizedly for any occasion in future, failing which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.

Now therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

- i. accept the joining of Dr. Sashank Sharma, Medical Officer, notionally from the date he has submitted joining report in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu i.e. 05-10-2020 and monetarily with immediate effect.
- ii. treat the remaining period of undergoing of higher studies (DNB Superspeciality in Gastroenterology) at Batra Hospital and Medical Research Centre, New Delhi w.e.f 01.04.2020 to 04.10.2020 in favour of Dr. Sashank Sharma, Medical Officer as extension of joining time, which is without any financial implication. However, this shall be subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any Govt./private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Director, Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor.



Besides, the concerned doctor is **warned** not to leave his place of posting un-authorizedly for any occasion in future, failing which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.
