Consultant Gynae.

WHEREAS, Dr. Neelu Sharma, was appointed as Medical Officer vide Government Order No.710-HME of 1997 dated 12.08.1997 and the said doctor joined in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu on 26.08.1997;

AND WHEREAS, Dr. Neelu Sharma, was appointed as Consultant Gynae vide Government Order No.595-HME of 2009 dated 31.12.2009 and the said doctor joined in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu on 01.02.2011;

AND WHEREAS, after rejoining the doctor was adjusted at District Hospital, Samba vide Government Order No. 266-HME of 2019 dated 01.03.2019;

AND WHEREAS, Directorate of Health Services, Jammu has now forwarded the case of the doctor to Administrative Department for further instructions with regard to settlement of her period;

AND WHEREAS, the instant case has been examined in consultation with Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department (Chairman Departmental Designated Committee), and the department while taking considerate view in the matter, in the interest of patient care, decided to treat the period of Un-authorized absence (un-described purposes) w.e.f. 02.05.2017 to 19.07.2018, in favour of Dr. Neelu Sharma, Consultant Gynae. as "Dies-Non", subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any private sector for which an affidavit authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor. The concerned doctor shall also be warned not leave her place of posting un-authorizedly for any occasion in future, failing which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice. Besides, Directorate of Health Services, Jammu be asked to fix the responsibility who were dealing hands in Directorate and didn't initiate any action against her and report be furnished within a month positively.





Now, therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

- i. treat the period of un-authorized absence (un-described purposes) w.e.f. 02.05.2017 to 19.07.2018, in favour of Dr. Neelu Sharma, Consultant Gynae. as "Dies-Non", subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as was not employed in any private sector for which an affidavit authenticated by the 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor.
- ii. the concerned doctor is **warned** not to leave her place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action will be initiated against her without any further notice.

Besides, Directorate of Health Services, Jammu is asked to fix the responsibility who were dealing hands in Directorate for not initiating any action against her and a report be furnished in this regard within a month positively.
