**Government Order No: 142 -JK(HME) of 2021**  
**Dated: 25 -02-2021**

WHEREAS, on the recommendations of the J&K Public Service Commission, sanction was accorded, vide Government Order No. 938-JK(HME) of 2020 dated 31-12-2020 and Government Order No 56-JK(HME) of 2021 dated 22-01-2021, to the temporary appointment of 612 (Six hundred & twelve) candidates, in respect of whom recommendations were released, as Medical Officers in the Jammu and Kashmir Health and Family Welfare (Gazetted) Service in the pay scale, Level-9 (Rs.52700-166700), along-with their postings, subject to fulfillment of all other usual terms and conditions of appointment;

AND WHEREAS, the whole recruitment process of Medical Officers has been completed within the shortest period with the sole purpose to neutralize the crisis of non availability of doctors and to provide better health care facilities to the people living in peripheral and far flung-areas of the UT of J&K;

AND WHEREAS, Article 47 (PART IV DIRECTIVE PRINCIPLES OF STATE POLICY) of the Constitution of India clearly envisages that it is the duty of the State to raise the level of nutrition and the standard of living and to improve public health;

AND WHEREAS, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case titled Paschim Banga Khet Mazdoor Samity Vs State of West Bengal, AIR 1996 SC 2426: (1995)6 SCC 213 has ruled that the constitution envisages establishment of a welfare state, and in a welfare state, the primary duty of the Government is to provide adequate medical facilities for the people. The Government discharges this obligation by running hospitals and health centers to provide

medical care to those who need them. "Article 21 imposes an obligation on the state to safeguard the right to life of every person. Preservation of human life is thus of paramount importance;

AND WHEREAS, the Health & Medical Education Department vide communication No. HD/GAZ/GEN/153/2020-II dated 12.02.2021 requested Director Health Services, Jammu/Kashmir to furnish the details of all such Medical Officers (Appointees) who have submitted their joining reports within prescribed period of time but formally submitted resignation from their respective place of posting and those who have submitted their joining reports within prescribed period of time but are not physically continuing at their respective place of postings (i.e absconding from place of posting) and those who have been allowed to join after prescribed period time in violation of conditions laid down in their appointment orders, if any and action taken against such DDO;


AND WHEREAS, the Director, Health Services, Kashmir vide communication No. Est/3/1-133/3471 dated 17-02-2021 & Director, Health Services, Jammu vide communication No. DHSJ/ES-3/3698 dated 16.02.2021 furnished the information/particulars of Medical Officers, who have submitted their joining reports but have submitted their resignation formally as indicated in **Annexure 'A'** and also of those Medical Officers who after submission of their joining reports are absconding from their respective place of postings till date as indicated in **Annexure 'B'**;

AND WHEREAS, the matter has been examined/ considered in the Administrative Department with reference to the basic purpose of appointment of these Medical Officers and the rules governing the subject. As such, it has been found that the above said doctors are still on probation, on account of which they are liable to be discharged from service, by terminating their probation in terms of Rule 21(1) & Rule 33 (2) & (3) of the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956;

Now, therefore, it is hereby ordered that:-

- i. in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 21(1) of the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control and Appeal) Rules, 1956, the probation of 9 Medical Officers as indicated in **Annexure 'A'** to this order is terminated and they are discharged from the J&K Health & Family Welfare (Gazetted) Service on their own request from the dates shown against each. As such, their resignations are accordingly accepted.

- ii. in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 21(1) and Rule 33 (2) & (3) of the J&K Civil Services (Classification, Control and



Appeal) Rules, 1956, the probation of 12 Medical Officers as indicated in **Annexure 'B'** to this order is hereby terminated and they are discharged from the J&K Health & Family Welfare (Gazetted) Service as they only submitted their joining reports and are absconding from their respective place of postings till date in violation of laid down terms and condition of their initial appointment orders.


