Sanction is hereby accorded to the following for implementation of the District Residency Programme in the Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir:

- A) Constitution of UT Level Steering Committee,
- B) Designation of Divisional Level District Residency Programme (DRP) Nodal Officers and;
- C) Designation of District Residency Programme Coordinator (DRPC).

The composition of Steering Committee vis-à-vis details with respect to Nodal Officers/Coordinator along with Terms of Reference in respect of each is given here as under:

A) UT Level Steering Committee

Principal, ASCOMS, Jammu shall also be the co-opted (Non-Official) Member of the said Committee.

Terms of Reference:

- The committee shall be responsible for facilitating implementation, oversight and supervision of the District Residency Programme in the UT of Jammu & Kashmir.

B) Designation of Divisional Level District Residency Programme (DRP) Nodal Officers:

1. Registrar Academics, Govt. Medical College, Srinagar (for Kashmir Division).
2. Director (Coordination), New Government Medical Colleges, J&K, Jammu (for Jammu Division).

Terms of Reference:

- I. The Divisional Level District Residency Programme (DRP) Nodal Officers shall undertake rule-based allotment of the training facilities to the Postgraduate Residents using the platform developed by the Board of Governors in supersession of Medical Council of India.
- II. The Divisional DRP Nodal Officers shall identify and designate hospitals that are suitable for such rotation in terms of the availability of specific specialties, specialists, facilities and services available in consultation with the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir/ Jammu and Medical Colleges, and develop a placement schedule of the Postgraduate residents of the medical colleges due for Rotation at least 06 months in advance.
- III. The Divisional Level DRP Nodal Officers shall also be responsible for grievance redressal at the divisional level.

C) Designation of District Residency Programme Coordinator (DRPC):

- Medical Superintendent of District Hospital implementing District Residency Programme.

Terms of Reference:

- I. The District Residency Programme Coordinator (DRPC) shall be responsible for orienting the postgraduate residents to the District health system, structure and functioning of the District Hospital, planning and supervising the postings and training programme.
- II. The District Residency Programme Coordinators shall be in-charge of the activities of DRP residents and shall coordinate with Divisional Level DRP Nodal Officers and the Medical Colleges.
- III. The DRPC shall also be responsible for making arrangements of logistics, transportation, accommodation and safety of the District Residents besides for redressing grievances, sanctioning leave to District Residents etc.
