**Subject:** Settlement of period of higher studies (PG course in PD-DNB & Fellowship in Gynecology Laparoscopy and Robotic) in favour of Dr. Samita Kumari, Medical Officer.

**Government Order No. 153 -JK(HME) of 2021**  
**Dated: 02.03.2021**

WHEREAS, Dr. Samita Kumari, was appointed as Medical Officer in the Health Services Department vide Government Order No.212-HME of 2007 dated 28.03.2007 and the said doctor reported in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu on 30.03.2007. However, said doctor was undergoing two years PG course (PD-DNB) at Apollo Gyane/Obstt. Hospital, Hyderabad w.e.f. 28.02.2014 to 17.06.2016 and the NOC was granted to undergo two years PG Course in (PD-DNB) at Apollo Gyane/Obstt. Hospital, Hyderabad vide Administrative Department Letter No. HD/Gaz/Gen/07/2014 dated 28.02.2014;

AND WHEREAS, thereafter, the aforesaid doctor left for another course Fellowship in Gynecology Laparoscopy and Robotic at Manipal Hospital, Bangalore w.e.f. 18.06.2016 to 06.04.2018 and left without obtaining permission/NOC of the Administrative Department;

AND WHEREAS, the department letter No. HD/Gaz/Gen/07/2014-PF dated 13.09.2018 conveyed approval of the Administrative Department to allow Dr. Samita Kumari to join the department w.e.f. 07.04.2018 i.e. the date on which she has submitted her joining report in the Directorate of Health Services, Jammu after completion of DNB Secondary in Obstetrics and Gynecology and Fellowship in Gynecology Laparoscopy and Robotic Surgery and her period for undergoing the said course shall be decided separately by the Committee constituted for the purpose;

AND WHEREAS, thereafter, the said doctor was posted at NTPHC Bhalwal Brahmana (Akhnoor) vide Government Order No. 670-HME of 2018 dated 06.12.2018;

AND WHEREAS, Directorate of Health Services, Jammu has forwarded her case regarding settlement of higher studies to Administrative Department for issuance of appropriate necessary instructions;.



AND WHEREAS, the instant case has been examined in consultation with Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department (Chairman Departmental Designated Committee), and the Department while taking considerate view in the matter, in the interest of patient care, decided to treat the period of undergoing PG course (PD-DNB) at Apollo Gynae/Obstt. Hospital, Hyderabad w.e.f. 28.02.2014 to 17.06.2016 in favour of Dr. Samita Kumari, Medical Officer, as leave whatever kind due except study leave and remaining period of short fall be treated as Dies-Non. Besides, treat the period of undergoing Fellowship in Gynecology Laparoscopy and Robotic Surgery, Manipal Hospital, Bengalure w.e.f. 18.06.2016 to 06.04.2018 in favour of Dr. Samita Kumari, Medical Officer as Dies-Non, subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as not employed in any Govt./Private Sector & no departmental enquiry is pending against her, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by the 1st Class judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Director, Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor. Besides, the concerned doctor shall be warned not to leave her place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice. Moreso, Directorate of Health Services, Jammu be asked to fix responsibility who were dealing hands in Directorate for not initiating any action against unauthorized absentee and a report in this regard be furnished within a month positively.

Now therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

- i. treat the period of undergoing PG course (PD-DNB) at Apollo Gynae/Obstt. Hospital, Hyderabad we.f. 28.02.2014 to 17.06.2016 in favour of Dr. Samita Kumari, Medical Officer, as leave whatever kind due except study leave and remaining period of short fall be treated as Dies-Non.
- ii. treat the period of undergoing Fellowship in Gynaecology Laparoscopy and Robotic Surgery, Manipal Hospital, Bengalure w.e.f. 18.06.2016 to 06.04.2018 in favour of Dr. Samita Kumari, Medical Officer as Dies-Non.

The aforesaid decisions (i & ii) shall be subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as not employed in any Govt./Private Sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against her, for which an affidavit duly authenticated by the 1st Class judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Director, Health Services, Jammu from the concerned doctor.

Besides, the concerned doctor is **warned** not to leave her place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against her without any further notice.

Moreso, Directorate of Health Services, Jammu is asked to fix the responsibility who were dealing hands in Directorate for not initiating any action against her and a report be furnished in this regard within a month positively.
