This sanction shall however be subject to the following terms and conditions:-

- (i) The case is genuine and course of higher studies has due regard to the exigencies of public service and would be of definite advantage to the department;
- (ii) There is dearth of such qualified officers in the Department.
- (iii) The officers shall have no superior claim over their seniors for consideration for promotion after acquiring higher/additional qualification.




- (iv) The stipend, scholarship etc, if any, received during the study leave is adjusted in their leave salary.
- (v) The officers have completed their period of probation satisfactorily.
- (vi) The university /Institute as well as the course is recognized under relevant norms.
- (vii) Total study leave availed by these officers shall not exceed three years in each case during the entire service.
- (viii) That there shall be no financial commitment from the Government.
- (ix) They will serve in the far flung areas for a period of three years after completion of their course/training.
