Subject: Settlement of period in favour of Dr. Nadeem Bashir, Medical Officer.

WHEREAS, Dr. Nadeem Bashir was appointed as Medical Officer in the Health Services Department vide Govt. Order No. 132-HME of 2014 dated 04.03.2014 and submitted his joining report in Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir on 08.03.2014;

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid doctor while posted in Block Mattan got selected for P.G course in the department of SPM at Government Medical College, Jammu and applied for three years study leave w.e.f 12.05.2019. Accordingly vide Govt. Order No. 550-HME of 2019 dated 13.06.2019, sanction was accorded to the grant of study leave in favour of aforesaid doctor for one year (out of three years) w.e.f 12.05.2019 to 11.05.2020.

AND WHEREAS, the aforesaid doctor submitted an application in Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir forwarded by HoD Community Medicine GMC Jammu vide letter dated 04.03.2020, whereunder he has requested for extension in study leave for further period of 02 years and the same was forwarded to the Administrative Department by Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir for grant of extension in the study leave and accordingly vide this department's letter No. HD/Gaz/Gen/47/2018 dated 21.08.2020, Director, Health Services, Kashmir was requested to obtain the Bond in Form-7 from the concerned doctor in the first instance and then submit the same to the Administrative Department for proceeding further in the matter;

AND WHEREAS, in the meanwhile, the aforesaid doctor has submitted an application in Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir on 16.07.2020 stated therein that due to his health issues, he has resigned from PG Course and has requested to allow him to join. However, the doctor has not been allowed to join till date by Director, Health Services, Kashmir as his case was submitted to the Administrative Department for extension in study leave for further period of 02 years;


AND WHEREAS, as per communication of Principal/Dean Govt. Medical College, Jammu dated 08.07.2020, it has been stated that Dr. Nadeem Bashir Pashoo was admitted during the session 2019 as PG student in the discipline of Community Medicine and he resigned on 08.07.2020;

AND WHEREAS, Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir has forwarded his case regarding settlement of period of higher studies (Senior Residency) to Administrative Department for issuance of appropriate necessary instructions;

AND WHEREAS, the instant case has been examined in consultation with Director Finance, Health & Medical Education Department (Chairman Departmental Designated Committee), and the Department while taking considerate view in the matter, in the interest of patient care, decided to accept the rejoining of Dr. Nadeem Bashir, Medical Officer w.e.f 16.07.2020 on notional basis and treat the period of absence w.e.f 11.05.2020 to 15.07.2020 and w.e.f 16.07.2020 till issuance of order in favour of Dr. Nadeem Bashir, Medical Officer as leave whatever kind due except study leave and remaining period of short fall be treated as Dies-Non, subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as he was not employed in any Government/Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir from the concerned doctor. Besides, the concerned doctor shall be warned not to leave his place of posting for any occasion in future unauthorizedly for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.

Now therefore, sanction is hereby accorded to:-

- i. accept the rejoining of Dr. Nadeem Bashir, Medical Officer w.e.f. 16.07.2020 on notional basis.
- ii. treat the period of absence w.e.f 11.05.2020 to 15.07.2020 and w.e.f 16.07.2020 till issuance of this order in favour of Dr. Nadeem Bashir, Medical Officer as leave whatever kind due except study leave and remaining period of short fall be treated as Dies-Non, subject to the condition that the said doctor was not involved in any subversive activities as well as he was not employed in any Government/Private sector and no departmental enquiry is pending against him, for which an affidavit authenticated by 1st Class Judicial Magistrate shall be obtained by the Directorate of Health Services, Kashmir from the concerned doctor.



Besides, the concerned doctor is warned not to leave his place of posting for any occasion in future un-authorizedly, for which disciplinary action shall be initiated against him without any further notice.
